

# RULEBOOK ON THE DETAILED MANNER OF USE OF TRAFFIC RECORDING DEVICES AND THEIR TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

## Article 1

This Rulebook prescribes the detailed manner of use of traffic recording devices and their technical specifications.

## Article 2

Systems used for traffic recording enable the monitoring of traffic safety, traffic flow, and the behaviour of traffic participants.

Traffic recording devices must enable the documentation of road events, the detection and recording of traffic offences and other violations, and operation in both daytime and nighttime conditions, as well as in all weather conditions, without affecting traffic safety.

Traffic recording devices for the detection and recording of offences use software solutions that enable the recognition of vehicle licence plates.

## Article 3

Fixed, portable, and mobile systems are used for traffic recording, as well as for detecting and documenting offences.

Within the systems referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article, devices for measuring vehicle speed in motion are also used for detecting and recording traffic offences, employing radio waves or laser beams to measure vehicle speed.

## Article 4

Appropriate telecommunications and power supply infrastructure must be provided for the operation of traffic recording devices. All components of traffic recording devices must be protected against mechanical damage, electromagnetic interference, unauthorized access, and other external influences.

## Article 5

Traffic recording devices, as well as all other designated equipment and devices, shall be installed above or alongside the road at designated locations, or in or on a motor vehicle, in accordance with the technical specifications of the traffic recording devices and the requirements of the user.

## Article 6



The position and placement of traffic recording devices, as well as the orientation of the camera lens, shall be determined individually for each specific location or motor vehicle, in accordance with the technical specifications of the traffic recording devices and the requirements of the user.

#### **Article 7**

Data archiving shall be conducted within the part of the traffic recording system intended for storing data related to traffic monitoring, detection, and recording of offences.

Data storage shall be conducted in accordance with the law governing the protection of personal data.

#### **Article 8**

This Rulebook shall enter into force on the eighth day following its publication in the "Official Gazette of Montenegro."
